



- 8. Unity and Collaboration: Foster a sense of unity, cooperation, and mutual support among mining cooperatives, enabling them to overcome challenges collectively.
- 9. Community Engagement: Promote cooperative initiatives that positively impact local communities, creating a harmonious relationship between cooperatives and the areas in which they

operate.

- 10. Resilience and Adaptation: Assist cooperatives in adapting to changing market conditions, technology advancements, and economic challenges, ensuring their continued success.
